Goal 1: Provide opportunities for undergraduates to take risks strategically and to achieve their potential as members of their communities.

Objectives:

1. Create opportunities for students to appreciate and tell their own stories.
2. Encourage students to develop resilience and flexibility.
3. Foster experiences for students to reimagine collectively the future.

Goal 2: Discover and communicate evidence-based practices that faculty, graduate students, postdoctoral scholars, and staff use to improve student success and learning.

Objectives:

1. Conduct and disseminate research on teaching, learning and academic support.
2. Provide professional development opportunities for staff that builds on their knowledge to maximize student success.
3. Provide professional development opportunities for faculty, graduate students, and postdoctoral scholars that builds on their knowledge of teaching to maximize student learning.
4. Support Academic Departments as they articulate a statement of educational excellence and how to measure them appropriately.

Goal 3: Foster educational success for UCI's diverse student population.

Objectives:

1. Provide targeted outreach to underserved and academically at-risk student populations.
2. Increase effectiveness of faculty, graduate students, and postdoctoral scholars in teaching diverse students.
3. Establish measures that capture the breadth of student success at UCI.
